The objectives of LTTA- Vieira do Minho, PORTUGAL

- **Dissemination of activities with students from partner institutions** (creating a corner of traditional musical instruments, visiting a music school, creating a PPT about a famous composer in the country of each partner, creating two videos where students play through the play back technique a famous song sung to traditional instruments and electronic instruments respectively);
- Establishing the anthem of the S.O.U.N.D.;
- Presentation of some of the products of the S.O.U.N.D. project, realized through the collaboration of all partners and finalized by two designated partners Book of Sounds (Poland), Basic Dictionary (Portugal);
- Establishing details of future project activities, in agreement with all partners;
- Familiarizing with Portugal's cultural life and traditions.

Preparations

Preparations for the LTTA of the "Silence of Our Unique Noise Dynamics" – S.O.U.N.D., Erasmus+ project in Portugal, took place in November-December 2018, the coordinating school made practical arrangements, such as booking the hotel, preparing the programme, providing information on how to arrive to school etc. Participants made travel arrangements: booking flights, buying insurance, prepared all the necessary information for the meeting.

Activities

Sunday, January 20, 2019, was a day dedicated to cultural visits. Thus the day began with a visit to Esposende and Póvoa de Varzim, two localities on the Atlantic Ocean. Lunch was served in a restaurant, located in Vila do Conde, a very picturesque port city. In the evening, the project partners gathered at a restaurant in the center of Braga and discussed the details of the next day.



















On **Monday, January 21, 2019,** at 10.00, Vieira do Minho, a meeting was held with teachers and students from the Portuguese partner institutions as well as representatives of the local government.



It presented an artistic program that included special moments of music and dance. The Portuguese students have prepared a dance specific to each partner country.

















Also at this meeting each partner had the opportunity to present their country and institution. Representatives of local authorities also took the floor, highlighting the important role that ERASMUS + projects have, and they are able to bring different countries to the same table, who share together special activities and share their experience in inclusive education.

The day continued with a visit to "Domingos de Abreu", where the hosts of Portugal hosted a warm welcome, a short artistic program (a dance attended by pupils with a song, performed on a suggestive song - Amigos Para Siempre) and visiting an institution with the presentation of its specificity.





Here too, in the Erasmus room, participants were invited to work with children and had the opportunity to see what the Portuguese partners did to make each country involved in the project known.



























The **next day's** visit was at the "Escola Básica do Cávado", where a special reception was also organized by the students of the school. Here, lunch was also served, consisting of traditional Portuguese dishes, prepared by the parents of the students in the school.





After school, the school was visited and the specifics of the activities taking place here were presented.





















The meeting of the project partners was further held, during which the results of the previous activities, which were carried out in a team, were disseminated. The Polish partners presented in their final form the Book of Sounds, both in electronic and on paper, each country receiving its own copies. The Portuguese partners have made the Basic Dictionary also in its final form.

The result of the vote, organized on-line, regarding the contest for setting up the hymn of the project S.O.U.N.D. The winner was nominated by the group created by the Turkey team.

The activity continued with other presentations of the activities of each partner in the project: the pupils created a presentation about a national composer and two videos, made with the rendering technique, in which a famous national song was rendered using traditional instruments, respectively electronic.







Dinner took place at a traditional Portuguese restaurant - Pancada.

Tuesday, January 22, 2019 were visited on the first day of the major tourist day in Braga: Pio XII Museum and Henrique Medina Medieval Tower, Sé de Braga Cathedral, Roman Baths.

After dining at the Central Do Bom Jesus Restaurant, a fine work on stringed instruments, supported by a well-known manufacturer, Domingos Machado, in his studio and then in the museum he created. It was a complete activity that had both technical explanations and practical demonstrations of using various string tools.























The evening dinner was accompanied by traditional musical portuguese, played by Os Bonitos, a group composed of several teachers and their friends.



On Wednesday, January 23, 2019, Guimarães was visited by a Special School, where people with disabilities benefit from different therapies but also carry out numerous activities that result in special finite products: painting, carpentry, weaving, ...



















After visiting two major historical sites in Guimarães, "Palácio Dos Duques" and the Guimarães Castle.



The evening was dedicated to traditional Fado music, in a Guimarães town - "Cantinho do fadista".

On January 24, 2019, it was a day dedicated to Porto. After a lunch with a certain city of Porto-Francesinha, a short cruise on the Douro River followed to admire the famous bridges crossing the river in several points and old buildings belonged to seafarers or wine houses.



Next came a traditional wine house in Porto, where the famous varieties of wines from Porto are made. The guide had an interesting presentation combining the history of wine in **Porto** with explanations of the technological process leading to its production.



















On Thursday, a meeting of project coordinators took place, setting out the details of future project activities.
